Horsemanship Program and Instruction

Lesson Tuition Fees

Using Kaliber Academy Horse

Monthly

A flat rate of \$200.00 for four lessons/ monthly. *must be used in 5 weeks

Pay Per Session

\$60.00 per session.

Trailer-Ins

Monthly

A flat rate of \$300.00 for four lessons/ monthly. *must be used in 5 weeks

Pay Per Session

\$75.00 per session.

*Riders will be placed according to skill level as well as availability into: private, semi-private, or a group session.

Requests for specific sessions will be taken into consideration.

*Trailer-in horses must have current Coggins Health Certificates and must be pre-approved to participate in anything but a private session.

Family Discount

- 10% off regular fees for total amount of riders.

Evaluation (30 Minute Private Evaluation for Placement)

- \$40.00 Per Individual - Private Session Only

Advanced Lesson Opportunity Sessions:

Full time students (weekly lessons at Kaliber Stables) are privy to "Activity Sessions." These sessions vary from shows to fun activity sessions and trail rides. All activities are considered lessons and part of the Horsemanship Program. Depending on the level of the rider and involvement, advanced lessons are offered. Monthly lesson fees will be prorated appropriately depending on desired involvement and acceptance into the advanced lesson sessions.

Kaliber Policies

Lesson Cancellation

A 24 hour notice for cancellations is required. Notice later than 24 hours or no call/no shows will result in forfeited sessions unless there is an emergency. Clients may re-schedule within the same week without penalty upon availability. If there is no attempt to make up the lesson within the week, the lesson will be forfeited. A four week session must be completed within 5 weeks from the date of purchase. Monthly lesson packages ensure a reserved time slot. Clients that choose the pay-per-session feature are subject to possible time changes. This will be strictly enforced.

Instructor cancellation or rescheduling does not result in a forfeit or apply to the expiration time frame. If any client is aware of an upcoming extended absence or other weekly obligations that may present consistent scheduling conflicts, we ask that you utilize the pay-per-session feature. All past due amounts will result in a \$50.00 late/non-payment fee each week payment is not received.

A \$50.00 NSF fee, plus bank charges will be enforced for all returned checks. If more than one check is returned for NSF payment will be limited to cash only. Services will resume when payment is received in full. No exceptions.

Inclement Weather

For the safety of the students and horses, certain weather conditions prohibit riding. It is up to the discretion of the instructor to decide if the weather is a safety concern. If it is decided that the conditions are too dangerous, lessons will be cancelled. The instructor will make an attempt to contact each student/parent.

***However, the instructor reserves the right to hold classes in undesirable riding conditions that focus on other aspects of Horsemanship than riding. This is a part of the Horsemanship Program and is equally important to the student's education.

Proper Riding Attire

Students/clients are required to wear proper riding attire. This includes: long pants suited for riding, boots with a flat heel (Roper style/Paddock boots,) and a helmet rated for horseback riding for those less than 18 years of age. Helmets/attire will not be provided by the Kaliber Stables. Clients who do not come to the lesson in proper attire will not be able to ride and will forfeit. No exceptions.

Monthly Invoice/Lesson Tracking

Clients have the right to request a monthly invoice or receipt for payment(s) If you do not wish to receive an invoice, your lessons will be tracked for quality control purposes. At any time you may request to know how many lessons are left in a package. It is up to the client to provide documentation of lessons used or not used if a disagreement arises.

Safety Guidelines

All clients/students/attending parties and participants are required to maintain the highest level of safety possible. Any person(s) disregarding this policy may be asked to leave the property and may result in a refusal of service. This includes and friends or family members that may attend a lesson.

Our safety guidelines include but are not limited to:

- Please avoid loud or disruptive behavior that might startle the horses, both during lessons and in the general area. Please keep arms and hands off the rail during lessons. Do not kick the rail. Do not put drinks on the rail that may fall into the arena. Always ask before using flash photography.
- Younger children can pose a great potential risk to both themselves and others. Please keep them attended at all times. Siblings are always welcome as long as they are continuously supervised.
- We ask that visitors do not give the horses any treats without permission as some are on a very strict diet.
- Proper footwear is required at all times while around the horses. No exceptions.
- Helmets are mandatory for all riders in the program 18 and under and are encouraged for those over 18.
- Riders that arrive without the proper gear will not be allowed to ride. (Kaliber has some helmets available to loan, but each rider must get their own within 30 days.)
- Please drive slowly and carefully as there are many children, horses, dogs, cats, etc. on the grounds.
- The viewing area is open for all family members or guests accompanying each rider. We ask that guests utilize this area to minimize congestion in the tack room and cross-tie area.
- When opening and closing doors, we ask that visitors use caution as sudden motion or noise from the door can startle the horses and pose a risk to the riders.
- Impaired or intoxicated guests will be asked to leave.
- Kaliber Stables reserves the right to dismiss students and/or guests that fail to observe these guidelines as they are in place for the safety and well-being of everyone.
